Under ECC's ride reimbursement policy, as revised beginning in 2012, ride reimbursement will be limited to \$250 per member, per year. You may be reimbursed for the cost of any cycling event for which an entry fee is charged – a century, a pledge ride, a multi-day event, etc. Members must wear their ECC club jersey (not a Tour jersey) for a non-race event, or an ECC race kit for a race, while participating in the event for which reimbursement is sought.

To qualify for reimbursement, a member must:

- 1) Work the Tour of Napa Valley
- 2) Participate in at least one Silverado Trail pickup
- 3) Help with at least one of the following:
 - a. Cherry Pie
 - b. Skyline Park Race
 - c. Serve as chairperson (yearlong volunteer commitments as listed in the newsletter):
